Baptism Regulations

August 12, 2002

- 1.0 Holy Baptism is the initiation into whole Christian family. We, the members of All Saint family, welcome all people who come to worship according to the rites of t Anglican Church of Canada and especially those who desire to participate in the baptism of a family member.
- 2.0 Baptism in All Saints Katepwa is reserved for those person or their families who:
 - 2.1 Worship in All Saints, Katepwa or
 - 2.2 Have a clear connection with All Saints' Katepwa
- 3.0 Because All saints is a temporary summer congregation, anyone requesting Holy Baptism, are asked to present a letter from the rector, minister or pastor of their home parish where they attend, or from where they are year round members.
 - 3.1 This letter will indicate the approval for the baptism along with the name, address and telephone number of the interested family.
- 4.0 All arrangements for the baptism must be made through the clergy responsible to All Saints' Katepwa. A member of the Worship Committee with then contact the family forth purpose of arranging the baptism.
- 5.0 It is appropriate to make a 'thank' offering donation to the church, and a receipt will be issued.
- 6.0 The Advisory Board reserves the right to waive these regulations in special circumstances.
