Wedding Regulations

May 1 2004

1.0 Members of adherents or family members, or permanent or summer residents of the Katepwa Lake area. Upon application and payment of the appropriate fees, may be considered to have their weddings performed in All Saints' Church.

1.1 A Saskatchewan Marriage License is required for all marriages and should be obtained at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the wedding.

1.2 Licenses are valid for three months from date of issue.

1.3 Please present the license to the minister at least a week prior to the wedding.

2.0 Good marriages just don't happen; it takes intentional work to ensure healthy relationships. For this reason couples will be required to take a Marriage Preparation course well in advance of the wedding date. Arrangements should be made in consultation with a minister.

3.0 Only the incumbent minister of All Saints' Church or his / her designate may officiate at the wedding. Visiting clergy from another denomination may assist.

4.0 The fee for the officiating minister will be a minimum of \$150, including travel; a minimum of \$50 for the organist; and a donation of \$100 to the church. A tax receipt for the latter will be issued, where clergy are from a long distance away, the additional travel will be negotiated.

5.0 No confetti or rice will be allowed in the church or churchyard.

6.0 The church has been designated as an historical site. Because of the fire hazard, we respectfully request that there be no smoking in the churchyard.

7.0 The Advisory Board reserves the right to waive these regulations in special circumstances.
